INVITATION TO BID FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF CE EQUIPMENT

1. The *Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC)*, through the *Notice of Fund Availability (NFA) dated April 5, 2021 from General Appropriations Act (GAA) FY 2021 dated 28 December 2020 of RA 11518* intends to apply the sum tabulated herein being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for each lot/item hereunder stated:

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The *Philippine National Police CES-BAC* now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required to be delivered within fifteen (15) working days for the Repair and Maintenance services after the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP). Bidders should have completed, within *three (3) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “*pass/fail*” criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from *CES BAC Secretariat, Logistics Section, PNP Communications and Electronics Service* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below starting **April 21, 2021** during office hours.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **April 21, 2021** during office hours from the given address and website below *and upon payment at the Finance Service, Camp Crame, Quezon City of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of stated above.*

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
