Invitation to Bid for Various Goods and Services

1. The Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC), through the **Notice of Fund Availability dated June 13, 2019 (Additional), and July 15, 2019 (Additional) from the General Appropriations Act (GAA) FY 2019 dated 29 April 2019 of RA 11260¹** intends to apply the sum tabulated herein being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for each lot/item hereunder stated:

Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC) now invites bids for one (1) lot Other Supplies and Materials, and one (1) lot Repair of Communications Equipment. Delivery of the Goods is required to be delivered within seven (7) working days while fifteen (15) working days for the Repair and Maintenance services, both after the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP). Bidders should have completed, within *three (3) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *CES BAC Secretariat, Logistics Section, PNP Communications and Electronics Service* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below starting **July 31, 2019** during office hours.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on **July 31, 2019** during office hours from the address below *and upon payment at the Finance Service, Camp Crame, Quezon City* of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount stated above.
