Invitation to Bid for Various Goods and Services

1. The Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC), through the **Notice of Fund Availability (NFA)** dated February 17, 2020 from General Appropriations Act (GAA) FY 2020 dated 6 January 2020 of RA 11465¹, intends to apply the sum tabulated herein being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for each lot/item hereunder stated:

Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC) now invites bids for one (1) lot of Office Supplies Expenses, one (1) lot of Other Supplies and Materials, one (1) lot of Repair and Maintenance of IT Equipment and one (1) lot of Repair and Maintenance of CE Equipment. Delivery of the Goods is required to be delivered within seven (7) working days while fifteen (15) working days for the Repair and Maintenance services, both after the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP). Bidders should have completed, within *three (3) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.
