Invitation to Bid Renovation of CES Multi-Purpose Hall Phase 1

1. The Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC), through the **Approved Program of Expenditures (POE-PA) of the PNP Trust Receipts for 3rd Quarter CY 2019 dated October 9, 2019 from the General Appropriations Act (GAA) FY 2019 dated 29 April 2019 of RA 11260¹** intends to apply the sum of **One Million Sixty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Pesos [Php 1,069,200.00]** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for each lot/item in CES2019-33: Renovation of CES Multi-Purpose Hall Phase 1.
Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Philippine National Police Communications and Electronics Service – Bids and Awards Committee (CES-BAC) now invites bids for one (1) lot Renovation of CES Multi-Purpose Hall Phase 1. Start date shall be within seven (7) working days after the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP). The completion shall be within or not exceed ninety (90) calendar days. Bidders should have completed, within *three (3) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *CES BAC Secretariat, Logistics Section, PNP Communications and Electronics Service* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below starting **October 22, 2019** during office hours.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on **October 22, 2019** during office hours from the address below *and upon payment at the Finance Service, Camp Crame, Quezon City of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount stated above.*

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
