Queries / For corrections	Clarifications
1. From: III. SCOPE OF WORKS, B. Actual Installation, Item number 9 of the Terms of Reference <u>"The winning bidder shall be responsible for the distribution, configuration, and installation of CPEs based on CES requirements, together with all the necessary accessories, and shall likewise shoulder its corresponding freight/ courier service charges."</u>	To: III. SCOPE OF WORKS, B. Actual Installation, Item number 9 of the Terms of Reference <u>"CPE/modem should be configured in bridged mode to allow for configuration of public IPs on Conventional Repeaters."</u>
2. Whether the bidder may be allowed to Subcontract?	Subcontracting is allowed only to places inaccessible or last mile areas to the winning bidder and make sure not to exceed 20% of the project. In addition, the winning bidder shall be the one to monitor the portion of the subcontractor until the completion of the project and not the procuring entity.

This document shall be an integral part of the Bidding Document.
